Rochester Christian University Teacher Candidate Certification and Employment Data

Incorporating data from MDE End of Year Evaluations and individually contacting each completer (2022-2023), the EPP determined the following:

- 11 (n=11; 100%) teacher candidates completed the program successfully
 - 7 Elementary
 - 4 Secondary
- 9 completers (n=9; 82%) became certified teachers
 - o 5 Elementary
 - 4 Secondary
- 9 completers responded to survey (n=9; 82%); 7 became employed teachers (n=7 of 9; 78%)
 - 5 Elementary (n=5)
 - 4 Full Time, 1 Building Substitute = 100%
 - 4 Secondary (n=2)
 - 2 Full Time, 2 Not Teaching = 50%

Analysis: The number of completers in 2022-2023 is consistent with the previous several academic years. Most of the completers (82%) passed the MTTC and were certified as teachers. Additionally, the majority (78%) gained employment as teachers.

Analysis: While Rochester Christian University is a private, Christian institution, the majority of program completers obtain employment in public school settings. This pattern has been demonstrated consistently over the past four academic years.
