POSITION DESCRIPTION:

The Crimson Leader (CL) is an integral member of Rochester Christian University's student engagement experience and is a three month commitment (June 10-August 29). The CL works closely with the Center for Student Life team and the Admissions Department to support the transition of Rochester Christian University's incoming students by creating and nurturing a welcoming educational, social and spiritual experience.

Relationship: The CL provides guidance and models social success to incoming 1st year students as they transition into the campus community. The CL's will regularly communicate with incoming students to promote community involvement, answer questions, and communicate important institutional information.

- Develop and maintain positive relationships with new students through availability, accountability, creativity, credibility, and confidentiality.
- Engage in a variety of communication efforts to promote community engagement.
- Guide students in personal, social, spiritual, and academic development.

Crimson Days:

- Attend and participate in all summer Crimson Days (June 17th, June, 26th, July 22nd, August 7th)
- Attend and actively participate in all set-up days for Crimson Days (June 16th, June 25th, July 21st, and August 6th)
- Introduce new students and their guests to staff and faculty, resources and spaces that RCU offers
- Inspire new students to pursue a path of engagement and excitement
- Affirm the decision that students have made to attend RCU

Warrior Week:

- Execute intentional events and activities that holistically engage new students
- Connect new students to returning students and engagement opportunities
- Introduce students to the surrounding area and its resources

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Must maintain a 2.5 GPA and be in good judicial standing with Rochester Christian University. If the student fails to maintain a 2.5 GPA, the student will be placed on an Academic Success Plan with their immediate supervisor.
- Personal life supports the mission, values and goals of Rochester Christian University
- Demonstrates enthusiasm for the university, students, faculty, staff and co-curricular programming
- Communicates effectively both verbally and written; as well as interactively with various technologies
- Demonstrates sensitivity/interest in diversity/cultural differences; ability to effectively communicate with a variety of personalities
- Functions effectively in a team environment
- Exhibits analytical and problem-solving skills
- Demonstrated ability to prioritize multiple tasks and responsibilities

POSITION COMPENSATION: Compensation for Student Leaders is determined by individual financial aid packages and institutional awards. The basic compensation structure for a Crimson Leader is as follows:

- \$12.75/hr paid bi-monthly over the course of the summer. Maximum of 75 total hours for the summer.
- Summer housing arrangements on campus, if needed
